 On the right side of the page, you will see Additional Resources where this information can be found. You need to open the Candidate Instructions link to find a digital copy of this page which will include the links.
- 2) nhsadvisor@spcsne.org has created a folder that will be shared with you after this meeting. This is where you will store all materials to be included with your application submission.
- 3) Complete application -
 - Make sure your name is included on the application
 - Fill out the application completely and honestly on your own
 - Make a <u>copy</u> of the Google Form to send to the adult sponsors for Adult Sponsor Verification with your name as part of the title of the Google Form OR get signatures on the application
 - Obtain Adult Sponsor Verification signatures for verification on the copied Google form.(if necessary)
 - Make sure the Google Sheet (where the responses are stored) is stored in the folder that is shared with nhsadvisor@spcsne.org NO LATER THAN 4:00 pm on February 23, 2024. If you need help sharing the google sheet, please ask Mrs. Lodes(if you aren't getting signatures on the application
- 4) Complete your video submission and put it in the folder shared with nhsadvisor@spcsne.org
 - Video submission is due NO LATER THAN 4:00pm on February 23, 2024
