

The Don & Judith Petersen Family Scholarship

Description of Scholarship: The Don & Judith Petersen Family Scholarship is awarded in memory of Judith Petersen who was a loving wife, mother and grandmother who dedicated 25 years working in the field of nursing. Judith's Husband Don, was a longtime, dedicated educator and involved in Athletics for 42 years and values the importance of giving back to the community. This scholarship will be awarded to two or more Platteview High School students who plan to pursue a career in education, health or medical professions.

Scholarship Value: \$250 scholarship paid in the year awarded.

Requirements:

- Applicants must attend Platteview High School
- Applicants must have maintained a minimum GPA of 2.75.
- Applicants must have plans to pursue a career in education or a health or medical profession.
- Applicants must exemplify good citizenship through active involvement in school and community and solid academic achievement.
- The Scholarship recipients must enroll at a post-secondary education institution.
- Only applications received by the Counseling Center on or before April 1st will be reviewed and forwarded to the respective scholarship selection committee for consideration. Any incomplete applications or applications that do not meet the requirements will be rejected
- 7th semester transcripts will be attached to the application by the high school counseling department.
