- 4. A short essay of no more than 500 words is required. Use one of the following two prompts to guide your essay:
 - How has community service helped prepare you for college?
 - How has the library (school or community) helped you in your education?

The scholarship award winners will be selected by The Friend's Scholarship Committee.
