Selection Process:

Students who have a minimum 3.5 (unweighted) cumulative GPA are eligible to fill out this information packet. The information packet must be turned in by 4:00 PM on February 10 to their shared Google Drive folder. If not, the student is no longer included in the application process. Once an application is turned in, it becomes the property of Platteview High School.

Students will also be required to do a timed write on February 1 or February 8. This will be a 20-minute essay on the topic of Service.

Students will also need to turn in a 2 - 3 minute video explaining why they think they would be an excellent candidate for Platteview High School's National Honor Society. This video must be uploaded to YouTube and the link sent to nhsadvisor@spscne.org. The video may remain private.

All High School faculty members will be asked to fill out the rubric on candidate students. Students must receive 21 points on the rubric without receiving a score below a 3 in the 5 point areas and below a 2 in the 3 point areas to advance to the Faculty Council screening.

The Faculty Council will meet to watch the video, view faculty input, and view the student's application to determine the selection status of each candidate.

All students will receive a letter stating their selection status.

Non-selection:

"Parents and students must understand that no student has a right to be selected for membership in a chapter of National Honor Society, and that the Faculty Council is entrusted with making selection decisions..."

"Schools are not obligated to share with parents and students, information concerning non-election of specific students. According to NASSP(National Association of Secondary School Principals) legal council, no constitutional due process requirements apply in non-selection cases."

"The National Council and the NASSP shall not review the judgement of the Faculty Council regarding selection of individual members to local chapters."
